

Press Note

Online application process for admission to the various M.Phil, courses in the University will begin from 3:00 PM on October 4, 2016. The admissions will be carried out on the same pattern as was done during the session 2015 – 16.

Eligibility of candidates for M.Phil. admissions will be as per the Ph.D. ordinance 2016. These are given below

- Candidates for admission to the M.Phil. programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
- The pattern of entrance test for M.Phil. admissions will be as similar to that given in the Ph.D. ordinance 2016. the details of this are given below:
 - All applicants seeking admission to the M.Phil. program have to appear in an entrance test organized by the concerned department/ Institute/Coordinator appointed by the Vice Chancellor, under the overall supervision of the University.
 - The syllabus of the entrance test will be the same as prescribed for the PG Programmes of the University of Lucknow.
 - The entrance test would be of 90 minutes duration. There would be a single question paper of 100 marks having 100 multiple choice questions for assessing the subject proficiency and research aptitude of the candidate. The entrance test shall have the minimum qualifying marks as 50%.
- **GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR ENTRANCE TEST**
 - The syllabus of the entrance test will be the same as prescribed for the PG Programmes of the University of Lucknow.
 - The entrance test would be of 90 minutes duration. There would be a single question paper of 100 marks having 100 multiple choice questions

for assessing the subject proficiency and research aptitude of the candidate.

- The entrance test shall have the minimum qualifying marks as 50%.
- Date of the entrance test will be announced within one week of the last date of filling of form is over on the Lucknow University website only.
- Venue for the entrance test would be the old campus of University of Lucknow for all subjects.
- No separate admit card will be issued for the entrance test. Applicants have to report to the test venue with a print out of the application form and a valid, photo ID.
- Candidates not having the relevant documents will not be allowed to appear for the test.
