### Press Note

On the request of several candidates who are appearing in various competitive examinations being held on Sunday, January 8, 2017 the document verification for admission to the M.Phil courses in English and Hindi has been rescheduled to be held on **January 9, 2017**. Candidates who were found eligible in the entrance test for admission held earlier have to report in the respective Department at **10:00 AM** along with the following documents.

- Application Form
- Original Photo ID
  - ***Photo copy of the Photo ID will not be accepted under any circumstances.***
- All Original Mark sheets and Certificates
- Caste certificates for all OBC, SC and ST candidates
- Valid Certificate of Non creamy layer OBC candidates who have claimed this category as eligibility
  - Candidates who have claimed to be in the OBC Non creamy layer have to show their certificate for this as the eligibility criterion for admission of such candidates is 50% marks. ***Those candidates who fail to produce this evidence and have below 55% marks will not be eligible to appear for interview.***
  - OBC certificates should be valid on the day of document verification.

### Admission fee submission

All candidates who report for document verification and are eligible for admission will have to deposit the admission fee by logging on to the M.Phil. admission website using their registration number and password from January 10 . 12, 2017. Only online modes of payment will be available. Those candidates who have forgotten their password can regenerate it by submitting the registration number on the forgot password page. The new password would be sent to their registered mobile number.

After submission of the admission fee the candidates can download their allotment letter and online fee receipt through this portal. Admitted students would have to report to the respective Department on the date notified along with this allotment letter.
