Entrance Examination for PG Programs

- Admissions to the PG programs will be given on the basis of entrance test based on the UG syllabus of Lucknow University. The details of the test (except for LL.B. three year, MCA and Faculty of Fine Arts) are given below.
- The entrance test will be of two hour duration and will comprise of three sections.

Section A

- This section would comprise of five questions of 5 marks each.
- Candidates would have to answer all of them in not more than 50 words for each question.
- This section would account for a total of 25 marks.

Section B

- This section would comprise of three questions.
- Candidates would have to answer any two of them in not more than 150 words for each question.
- Each question will be divided into a minimum of two segments.
- Each question would be for 15 marks. Therefore this section would account for a total of 30 marks.

Section C

- This section would comprise of two questions.
- Candidates would have to answer any one of them in not more than 300 words.
- Each question will be divided into a minimum of two segments.
- The question would be for 20 marks. Therefore this section would account for a total of 20 marks.

Entrance Examination for For LL.B. (Three Year) and MCA programs

- The entrance test for LL.B. (Three Year) will comprise of 100 multiple choice questions to be answered in 90 minutes and would comprise of Indian Polity: Structure and Functions, General Awareness, Logical Aptitude, Mental Ability.
- The entrance test for MCA will comprise of 100 multiple choice questions to be answered in 90 minutes and would comprise of Questions on BCA level, General Awareness, Logical Aptitude, Mental Ability
- **Marking Pattern:** Each question will be of 4 marks. One mark will be deducted for each incorrect answer. Zero mark will be awarded for each un-attempted question.

Entrance Examination for Master in Visual Art (MVA)

- Admissions to the MVA courses would be done on basis of entrance test details of which are as under
- MVA entrance test will be divided in three parts
- **Practical Examination**
 - Object drawing (pencil and shade) time 2 hours
- **Written Examination**
 - The written test would be of two parts. First part will be short answer type and second part will be long answer type. Second part will further have three divisions, each of one of the departments of the faculty. An

applicant has to answer questions belonging to the same department in which he/she seeks admission.

- **Interview**

- The candidate has to bring a portfolio of his/her work and will be asked questions by the interview panel.
